

Dear Mr. Lindsay:

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has received the above document on March 20, 2001. Based on a review of the data presented in the report, ADEC concurs with the conclusion in section 7.0 that no further action is required at the site known as the Pumhouse Lake. However, if in the future, additional contamination is discovered at this site, further investigation and/or remedial actions will be requested of NOAA by ADEC. ADEC reserves its rights, under 18 AAC 75 Oil and Other Hazardous Substances Pollution Control regulations and AS 46.03 to require NOAA to conduct additional assessment and/or corrective actions, if information indicates the site conditions pose an unacceptable risk to human health, safety, or welfare, or to the environment.
