

Some 450 employees have retired from positions throughout NOAA during 1973, many after long careers and notable accomplishments.

Among those who retired recently are:

--Donald F. Moore, who has been Assistant Administrator for Environmental Modification since May of 1972, and who earlier was one of the Environmental Science Services Administration leaders during the establishment of NOAA, and instrumental in preparing NOAA's first program plans;

--Clarence E. Roache, Deputy Associate Administrator for Environmental Monitoring and Prediction since 1971, who previously was Deputy Assistant Administrator for Environmental Systems with ESSA, and earlier was with the Federal Coordinator for Meteorological Services and Supporting Research;

--Rear Admiral Norman E. Taylor, Director of the Pacific Marine Center since 1967, whose assignments in 30 years in the Commissioned Corps included serving aboard 12 ships, commanding three of them, and serving with field parties in the continental U.S., and with a tides party in Hawaii;

--Guy H. Dorsey, Chief of NOAA's Personnel Division, who, except for Navy Service during World War II, has served continuously in the Commerce Department since 1935 and whose expertise in Personnel matters has been invaluable during major reorganizations of the former Weather Bureau and the creation of ESSA and NOAA;

--Donald C. House, Chief of Meteorological and Hydrological Services in the Office of Environmental Monitoring and Prediction, whose 32 years' service included being MIC at Kansas City, Mo.; Supervising Forecaster at the Severe Local Storms Unit; and Principal Assistant in the Kansas City Regional Office;

--Paul H. Kutschenreuter, Director of the National Weather Service's Pacific Region since 1968, whose 47 years' Federal service included the planning of a National Natural Disaster Warning Program concerned with detection, prediction, warning, and relief measures for natural disasters;

--Leonard M. Murphy, Director of the Seismological Investigations Group of the Environmental Research Laboratories' Earth Sciences Laboratories in Boulder, Colo., who was a leader in designing the seismic and tidal network throughout the Pacific Basin and in developing the worldwide network of seismograph stations; and

--Robert W. Schloemer, Executive Officer in the Office of the Director of the Environmental Data Service, whose many years in the Weather Service included serving as Assistant to the Director of the Office of Climatology.
