

Tiros Pinpoints Typhoon Location Within One Degree

WASHINGTON, April 11 (UPI)—Tiros I, America's seeing-eye satellite, pinpointed within one degree a fully-developed tropical typhoon east of Australia, it was revealed today.

News of the accuracy of the satellite's achievement came in a telegram from Dr. L. J. Dwyer, director of the Australian Meteorological Bureau, to the chief of the U.S. Weather Bureau.

The telegram read: "Heartiest congratulations on success of Tiros satellite."

In the telegram, Dwyer said Tiros had located the center of the tropical cyclone within one degree as confirmed by ship reports on the storm.
