The total receipts of mackerel at Portland on Tuesday were over 6000 pounds, 1600 pounds of which were landed by sch. Mary A.

Dog fish are causing the Portland netters lots of trouble, one fisherman finding his net full of them.

The Nova Scotia sch. Civilian reports speaking the Bucksport sch. Carlton Bell on the Banks recently with 100,000 lb. of fish.

The Murder Island, N. S. trap had 700 mackerel on Monday morning. A few were caught in nets in the vicinity.

The fare of sch. Emerald sold to Hall & Co. at \$7.50 per bbl. and that of sch. Lucille to the Gloucester Mackerel Company at \$7 5-8 per bbl.

At Rockport this morning are schs. Marguerite with 400 fresh mackerel, sloop On Time, 230 fresh mackerel; sloop Sylvester, 200 fresh mackerel; sloop Magnolia, 700 fresh mackerel and sloop Florence with 200 fresh mackerel.

The fleet is now mostly off South Shoal lightship, where the recent hauls have been made. There were 65 sail where sch. Emerald got her fish.

Fresh mackerel at Boston started at 7 cents for large and 3 cents for medium and dropped to 2 1-3 cents on the latter later in the forenoon.

Salt mackerel sold in Boston Thursday at \$7.75 per bbl.

The netters have found fish to the eastward, for there are 125 barrels of net mackerel at Boston from Portland to-day, also 150 barrels from Cape Cod and 548 barrels from Newport.

To-day salt mackerel receipts here aggregate about 1000 barrels.

Several fares aggregating 500 barrels of salt mackerel and 600 barrels of fresh mackerel are at Boston to-day.
