PACIFIC HALIBUT HERE.

First Carload Ever Brought to This City.

Came to American Halibut Co. This Morning.

This morning's freight brought to this city the first carload of Pacific halibut ever brought to this city. The shipment came through in splendid condition. It was shipped from Tacoma by the International Fisheries Company, many of whose stockholders reside here, and was consigned to the American Halibut Company who will distribute it from here in filling orders.

Besides this carload, the International Fisheries Company has one at Boston and two at New York today.

Bay of Islands Freezing Over.

A dispatch from St. Johns, N. F., says: This island is now in the grip of a severe cold wave which, it is expected, will immensely improve the frozen herring fishery at Placentia and Fortune Bays, where the fish have been lying in deep water. Bay of Islands is now freezing over. All vessels have left the bay and the fishing there has been virtually abandoned for the season. In other bays the industry will be pursued until the end of February.
