

SCIENTISTS SUCCESSFUL.

Take Plaster Cast of Mammoth Whale.

Is for Exhibition for St. Louis Exposition.

Halifax, July 14, 1903.—News received here from St. John's N. F., says that the American scientists who were at Balena to make a plaster cast of a whale for the St. Louis Exposition, returned today, having had fullest success in their mission. They secured a splendid "bull" fish, a sulphur bottom, 78 feet long, and weighing about 70 tons. They made a cast of this, stripped off the flesh, cleaned the skeleton and brought it with them. The frame of the head is 19 by nine feet, and weighs three tons.
