WEEKLY FISH MARKET.

There has been little of note in the local fish market the past week. The trade is termed quiet by the shippers. Prices from the vessels are firm and in some cases, notably bank cod, have shown a sharp advance, but on the other hand, while there has been no break, the cured fish market is weak in spots, taking last sales as a basis.

No Newfoundland salt herring have arrived as yet but the dealers are preparing for a busy smoked bloater season, as orders and inquiries indicate a big demand.

Several second salt bank fares have arrived and two of them were unexpectedly good.

Another cargo of Newfoundland cod is on the way, this one from Grand Bank, Fortune Bay.

The pollock fleet has done practically nothing and the season is apparently about over.

Louisburg, C. B., Fishing Season Over.

The fishery season at Louisburg, C. B., may now said to have closed. There may be a few days yet when a few codfish will be taken, but the general fishing season is over. The fall run of mackerel did not strike there. The fish in all probability passed far out from the land, much farther out than the fishermen had their nets set. The catch of mackerel on the whole is below that of last season, the spring run of these fish being much in decrease of last year. The herring catch is also much less than last year. The usual run of summer herring did not strike in on the coast last summer. The prices of all kinds of fish are high, however, and this will tend to make the season a profitable one to fishermen, even though the catch is below the average.
