WEEKLY FISH MARKET.

Some of the shippers report a fair trade this week, an improvement over last week, while others report it about the same as last week. Three cargoes of salt herring have arrived and the smoked bloater business is well under way and at the present writing at least 11 of the remaining 19 vessels at Bay of Island for salt herring are loaded or on the way home with cargoes.

Bank cod have been in fairly liberal receipts, caused by the arrival of several of the salt bank fleet, some of whom had good and others small fares. The total of the second trips will show a considerable decrease as compared with last season's figures. The pollockers had a good spurt last Sunday but since then have done nothing. All ground fish, fresh, are in light receipt.

The feature of the week has been the agreement of the smokers in a uniform price of smoked bloaters to the trade and the attempt of the producers of salt herring and the smokers to arrange for a uniform price for all the salt herring fares to come. Thus far no agreement has been reached by them.

Prices in all grades of fish are firm and high, a good advance appearing in some lines. One small lot of selected cured Georges brought \$7.25, but the market is still firm at \$7. Bank cod took another raise, due in part to spirited bidding between two large concerns.
