MILES OF DEAD HERRING.

Sighted by Ocean Liner on Grand Bank Recently.

Dead herring floated on the water for 15 miles in the path of the Danish steamer Texas, which arrived yesterday from Copenhagen. Capt. Anderson encountered the herring on the eastern edge of the Grand Banks. He is unable to say whether they were killed by a submarine disaster or a fishing vessel had foundered near by. A dory full of water adds plausibility to the latter theory.

The herring probably came from the Boston sch. Mary G. Powers which foundered in that vicinity some time ago. She was loaded with herring to bait the salt fishermen on the banks.

COULD NOT PASS IT.

Resolution Abrogating Modus Vivendi Discussed at Amherst, N. S.

A Halifax dispatch of yesterday says:

"At the annual meeting today, at Amherst, of the Maritime Board of Trade, representing commercial interests of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island, a resolution was proposed by Halifax and Digby delegates, urging abrogation of the modus vivendi between Canada and the United States under which American fishermen are granted certain privileges of taking bait and ice and transshipping their catch in Canadian ports. The matter was finally referred to a committee."
