Big Sharks at T Wharf.

Capt. John Swasey of sch. Louise R. Sylva had one of the largest and hungriest looking sharks yesterday ever brought to T wharf. It was 15 feet in length. Capt. Swasey was fishing at the channel, and was troubled greatly by sharks. To get rid of some of them he threw overboard a piece of cloth, and stood on the deck with a lance. The big shark approached and as it was about to seize the cloth Capt. Swasey planted the iron in the monster, and one of the men secured it with a gaff. The fish was sold.

Capt. Hutchins of sch. Olive F. Hutchins also brought in a 10-foot shark, which was taken on a trawl by Fred Eaton, one of the crew, after a long fight.
