Twelve gill netters lifted yesterday and landed 25,000 pounds of fresh fish between them.

## PRICE OF FRESH MACKEREL DOWN

### THREE TO FOUR CENTS AT BOSTON—TEN TRIPS TALLING 81,000 POUNDS.

The Boston fleet numbered 25 this morning, 10 with mackerel, three with halibut and the rest with groundfish. Total receipts were 555,000 pounds of groundfish, 59,000 pounds of halibut, 81,000 pounds of fresh mackerel, 90,000 pounds of mixed fish, 18,000 pounds of sole and 4000 pounds of saltfish. Trading was not very brisk. Haddock sold at \$2.50 to \$3; large cod, \$4; markets, \$2 and mackerel, 3 to 4 cents. Halibut was high at 26, 24, 21 and 18 cents per pound.
