GILL NETTERS LANDED 300,000

PIER LANDINGS GOOD LAST WEEK

For the week ending November 3 there were 170 arrivals at the Boston fish pier with 5,569,500 pounds of groundfish. In the corresponding week of 1929, there were 149 arrivals with 5,011,400 pounds.

Fram January 1 to date there have been 5521 arrivals with 238,970,925 pounds as compared with 4950 arrivals and receipts of 225,625,512 pounds in the same period of 1929.

HADDOCK UP TO \$10 AT BOSTON

ONLY SMALL SUPPLY OF FRESH
FISH AVAILABLE AT HUB
THIS MORNING.

Small receipts and a brisk demand sent prices soaring at the Boston fish pier this morning when trading was resumed after the holiday. There were 19 vessels in the dock at the opening. Fares, particularly the steamers, were very small.

The total was 457,000 pounds of groundfish, 100,000 pounds of mixed fish and 4000 pounds of fresh mackerel. Haddock opened at \$9 to \$10; large cod, \$10 and markets, \$5 to \$6. Mackerel sold for 13 cents.
