

ONLY DOZEN IN BOSTON'S FLEET

RECEIPTS ARE SMALLER TODAY,
BUT PRICES HAVE MOVED
UPWARD

A dozen boats made up the fleet at the Boston fish pier this morning. Five of them were beam trawlers, one dragger with redfish and the rest small boats from shore fishing. Total receipts were 216,000 pounds of groundfish, 190,000 pounds of redfish and 234,400 pounds of mixed fish. Haddock sold at \$4.50 on the opening; large cod, \$3.50 and markets, \$2.50.

Two large lots of frozen swordfish are due to arrive in Boston soon, 16,000 pounds on November 1, and 50,000 pounds on November 12.
