In reply to yours of October 3rd, 1905, I, herewith, furnish you the information asked for, taken from our records which are sworn to by the master of the vessel, but which are not verified by a Customs officer.

"Jinsei Maru", cleared Sept. 21, 1905, for Hakodate, No. of fish 69,300, at 5 pounds each is 346,500 pounds, valued at \$3,465.00.

"Agenor" cleared October 13, 1905, with 250,000 fish, 875 tons or 1,750,000 pounds, valued at \$32,480.00.
