Alaska, 370 cases of red salmon.

✓ Pavlof Harbor Packing Co., Seattle, shipped 415 cases of
salmon, and according to Mr. O'Connor they packed about 8,000
cases.

✓ Petersburg By-Products Co., Petersburg, Alaska, shipped
25,300 pounds of fertilizer.

✓ Fish Cannery *534 Henry Bldg.* By-Products Co, Wards Cove, Alaska, shipped
both oil and fertilizer. (I thought this was a defunct organ-
ization in 1919 or before, but it appears to have come to life
again)

✓ Mrs. E. O. Ketzmann, Seldovia, Alaska, shipped some canned
and salt salmon, shipment being made to Getz Bros. & Co., San
Francisco.

By-Products Co., and Mrs. E. O. Ketzmann. ✓


