Dear Mr. Anderson:


In looking through my files in this office I fail to find any record of the 1921 salmon pack of Charles Myers (Seldovia Canning Company.)

Joint operations of Hillery-Scott Co. and the King Salmon Fisheries Co. in 1920 produced an additional 294 cases of kings and 3,960 cases of reds.

There appears to be no report from "The B. and M. Hand Cannery, Latouche." Perhaps report was made under another name. No information can be given in regard to the pack.

The Bureau realizes that it is probably quite difficult to secure data from many of the small operators, as much difficulty is experienced in obtaining the reports required by law, but it is hoped that you will be able to secure sufficient reliable information for the preliminary report contemplated.
