


Permit # 106

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE
BUREAU OF FISHERIES



Ikatan, Alaska, May, 25, 1922.

Permission is hereby granted to Edward Smith, a resident of King Cove, Alaska, fish for, smoke and put up not to exceed (3000) Three Thousand Salmon of all species.

Fishing operations to be conducted at Thin Point, Alaska Peninsula, Alaska.

Fishing Gear to consist of Beach Seine and Gill Net; provided that the Permittee shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the Fisheries of Alaska, a copy of which is attached hereto, as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

This permit expires December, 31, 1922 and is not transferable.
