PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERIES OPERATIONS WITHIN
THE SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION

February 27, 1923.

A reservation designated as the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation having been created by the Executive order of November 3, 1922, John M. Brodtkorb, whose post office address is Uyak, Alaska, is hereby authorized to catch and prepare salmon for fox feed, and to salt salmon for commercial purposes, such fish to be taken in Shelikof Strait between Kiukpalik Island and the mainland, within Zone 3, of Kodiak-Afognak District, of said reservation, during the calendar year of 1923, under the following conditions:

1. That fishing gear may consist of (a) 1 beach seine 60 fathoms in length; and (b) 2 set gill nets of 60 fathoms each, the mesh of which shall not be less than $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches nor more than 6 inches, stretched measure between knots; these nets to be operated between Kiukpalik Island and the mainland.

2. That the permittee may salt and pack not to exceed 100 standard barrels of salmon bellies; provided, however, that the backs of such salmon shall not be wasted but shall be saved and utilized for fox feed or other food purpose.

3. That the catch of all species of salmon for fox feed and other commercial purposes, as above specified, shall not exceed 20,000 fish.

4. That the permittee shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the fisheries of Alaska and for the administration of the said reservation, (copies of which are attached hereto and the conditions of which are made a part of this permit), as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

5. That this permit expires December 31, 1923, is not transferable and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
