SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION



THIS IS TO CERTIFY That Albert Johnson, whose post office address is Anchorage, Alaska, is hereby authorized, during the calendar year 1923, to engage in commercial fishing for salmon, on a small scale, in the northern part of Cook Inlet, Knik Arm vicinity; and may operate one (1) 25-fathom king salmon gill net. Fresh salmon may be sold to any company or individual authorized to operate within the Cook Inlet District of the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation.

The permittee shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the fisheries of Alaska and for the administration of the said reservation, (copies of which are attached hereto and the conditions of which are made a part of this permit), as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

This permit expires December 31, 1923, is not transferable and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
