
PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERY OPERATIONS WITHIN THE
SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION

Permit No. Cordova 84-1923, April 24, 1923.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That the above named persons, whose post office address is Afognak, Alaska, and who are bona fide residents of Spruce Island, are hereby authorized, during the calendar year 1923, to engage in commercial fishing for salmon, within the Seal Bay Fishery, of the Afognak Reservation; and may operate jointly one (1) 110-fathom salmon beach seine. Fresh salmon may be sold to any company or individual authorized to operate within Zone 3, of the Kodiak-Afognak District of the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation.

The permittees shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the fisheries of Alaska and for the administration of the said reservation, (copies of which are attached hereto and the conditions of which are made a part of this permit), as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

This permit expires December 31, 1923, is not transferable and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
