

PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERY OPERATIONS WITHIN THE  
SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION

Permit No. 42-1924.  
Uganik Packing Company.  
Uganik Bay.

A reservation designated as the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation having been created by the Executive Order of November 3, 1922, the Uganik Packing Company, whose home office is at Kodiak, Alaska, is hereby authorized to operate its plant for the salting of herring for commercial purposes on the northeast arm of Uganik Bay, within Zone Three of the Kodiak-Afognak district of the said reservation, during the calendar year 1924, under the following conditions:

1. That the division of the district into zones shall not apply to herring operations because of the migratory character of the schools of herring. Fishing for herring may therefore be carried on anywhere within the Kodiak-Afognak district, provided that herring purse seines may not be operated within the bays and harbors of the Afognak Reservation unless they are manned by natives who are privileged to fish within the reservation. And further provided that in the preparation of herring products within the Afognak Forest and Fish Culture Reserve so far as possible all work in connection with the taking of herring and their subsequent preparation for market shall be performed by natives who are residents of the said reservation.

2. That the company may operate one herring seine, one herring pound, and one pound seine.

3. That this permit does not grant any right to fish for salmon within the waters of the reservation, but salmon taken in herring operations may be salted in an amount not exceeding 150 barrels.

4. That the company shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the fisheries of Alaska and for the administration of the said reservation (copies of which are attached hereto and the conditions of which are made a part of this permit), as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

5. That this permit expires December 31, 1924, is not transferable, and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
