

PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERY OPERATIONS WITHIN THE  
SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION

Permit No. 62-1924.

Kodiak Island Fishing and Packing Co., Inc.  
Uganik Bay.

A reservation designated as the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation having been created by the Executive Order of November 3, 1922, the Kodiak Island Fishing and Packing Company, Inc., whose home office is at Seward, Alaska, is hereby authorized to operate its plant for the canning of salmon and the salting of herring for commercial purposes in Uganik Bay, within Zone Three of the Kodiak-Afognak district of the said reservation, during the calendar year 1924, under the following conditions:

1. That the company may operate five (5) beach seines in any of the following locations: Uganik Bay, Terror Bay, Viekoda Bay, and the waters of Shelikof Strait from Cape Ugat to Raspberry Strait. Fishing permits within the Afognak Forest and Fish Culture Reserve will be granted only to natives, in accordance with regulations now in force, and natives fishing within the Afognak Reservation have unrestricted privilege to sell to any purchaser the proceeds of their fishery.

2. That the pack of all species of salmon shall not exceed fifteen thousand (15,000) cases, computed upon the basis of 48 one-pound cans per case.

3. That the company may operate two (2) herring purse seines, and that fishing for herring may be carried on anywhere within the Kodiak-Afognak district, provided that all such fishing within the waters of the Afognak Forest and Fish Culture Reserve shall be by natives who are privileged to fish within the reservation.

4. That the company shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the fisheries of Alaska and for the administration of the said reservation (copies of which are attached hereto and the conditions of which are made a part of this permit), as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

5. That this permit expires December 31, 1924, is not transferable, and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
