

SUPPLEMENTARY PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERY OPERATIONS WITHIN
THE SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION

Supplementary Permit No. 66-a-1924.

Three Mile Creek.

A permit, No. 66-1924, having been granted to J. A. Magill under date of November 15, 1923, for the catching and salting of salmon for commercial purposes at Three Mile Creek, within the Cook Inlet District of the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation, permission is hereby also given for the operation of apparatus for the capture of salmon as follows:

1. That the permittee may operate four (4) 30-fathom king salmon gill nets between Beluga River and Chuit River, on the west shore of Cook Inlet.

2. That this permit expires December 31, 1924, is not transferable, and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
