

SUPPLEMENTARY PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERY OPERATIONS WITHIN
THE SOUTHWESTERN ALASKA FISHERIES RESERVATION

Supplementary Permit No. 67-a-1924.

December 11th 1923.

A permit, No. 67-1924, having been granted to Thomas S. Haynes under date of November 24, 1923, for the operation of a clam cannery at Swikshak Bay, within the Kodiak-Afognak District of the Southwestern Alaska Fisheries Reservation, permission is hereby also given for the taking and preparation for market of crabs and of clams other than razor clams in the season of 1924, under the following conditions:

1. That the permittee may fish for crabs and clams from Cape Tonki along the northern and western shores of Afognak Island, including Shuyak Island, to Raspberry Cape, and along the western shore of Shelikof Strait southward from Cape Douglas, except on the beaches where the Hemrich Packing Company is authorized to take clams.

2. That the operations under this supplementary permit are to be of an experimental nature and no pack limit is imposed with regard to crabs and clams other than razor clams.

3. That this permit expires December 31, 1924, is not transferable, and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
