

PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN FISHERY OPERATIONS WITHIN THE
ALASKA PENINSULA FISHERIES RESERVATION

A reservation designated as the Alaska Peninsula Fisheries Reservation having been created by the Executive Order of February 17, 1922, the Alaska Commercial Company, whose post office address is Unalaska, Alaska, is hereby authorized to engage in the preparation of salmon and codfish at Unalaska, within the Aleutian Islands District of the said reservation during the calendar year 1924, under the following conditions:

1. That all fishing shall be carried on by natives from whom the catch may be purchased, but the total pack shall not be in excess of 100 barrels of salted salmon and 40 barrels of codfish.

2. That the company shall observe the existing laws and regulations for the protection of the fisheries of Alaska and for the administration of the said reservation (copies of which are attached hereto and the conditions of which are made a part of this permit), as well as those that may hereafter be enacted or promulgated for such purposes.

3. That this permit expires December 31, 1924, is not transferable, and is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Secretary of Commerce.
