Stream No. 21 (2 notices) West side Cochran Bay.

There are five small clear-water streams here and two big glacier streams.

The south side stream is 40 feet wide and 8 inches deep; north side stream is slightly larger.

The five clear-water streams run about 11 feet wide and 5 inches deep, and have most of the fish, although the short glacier stream on the south has quite a few.

July 26, 1926.....7,000 fish.

August 13, 1927.....5,000.

August 21, 1928.....9,000.

August 20, 1929.....12,000, 8% chums.

August 16, 1930.....700, 30% chums.
