

REPORT OF EXAMINATION OF ALASKA SALMON STREAM

Name of stream Redoubt Date examined August 19, 1926.

Location Redoubt Bay

Approximate length 100 ft Width 50 ft Depth 18 inches

Condition and stage (Whether clear, high, low, etc.) Water clear, low.

Lakes, if any, size, character, and whether accessible from sea Lake about 9 miles. long.

Salmon run (heavy, light, average, etc.) Very light run.

Date and duration of run of each species. Reds from June 6th to August 30.
Humpies from August 10 to September 2.

Estimated number of each kind of salmon on spawning beds or in stream Reds, 25,000. Humpies 20,000. Dogs 500. Cohos 1,000.

Former size of runs of each species and evidence of depletion, if any. Big depletion in reds. Large increase in humpies, average run of cohos and dogs.
