Stream No. 11 (2 notices for 11 and 12) Head Sheep Bay
Is 30 feet wide and 7 inches deep.
Coarse gravel with a mixture of fine bottom.
Accessible about 1 mile, but water swift after 1/2 mile
and fish thin above there.
(No visit '26)
Oct. 5, 1927,--46,000 fish--about all dead.

Stream No. 12. (Under above) Head Lagoon, Sheep Bay.
Is 75 feet wide 9 inches deep.
Coarse granite gravel bottom.
The valley is about level for quite a distance.
Fish thin and water swift above 2,000 feet.
Oct. 5, 1927----15,000 fish.

Stream No. 13 (2 notices) North side near entrance Sheep Bay
Is 12 feet wide and 6 inches deep.
Has a rough boulder and fine gravel bottom.
Might be accessible 1/4 mile.
No visit 1926.
Oct. 5, 1927-----about 200 fish spawned here.

Stream No. 14 (2 notices) Hawkins Island,--north side.
There is a small lagoon here, about 1,000 feet.
Stream at head of lagoon is 10 feet wide and 3 inches deep.
It has a rough, broken rock bed.
Is accessible about 1,500 feet.
Only 300 fish spawned here--visit Oct. 5, 1927.

Stream No. 15 (2 notices) Windy Bay, Hawkins Island.
Is 10 feet wide and 6 inches deep.
Has a coarse gravel bottom.
Accessible about 5,000 feet but not many signs of fish
above 2,000 feet.
The bay is shallow at head.
Sept. 14, 1927 visit---3,000 fish spawned here.
