

CHART 8550

Stream No. 22 Hobo Bay, Port Wells.

Is 30 feet wide and 10 inches deep.

The first 400 feet of it is through a canyon with a rough, rocky bottom and swift water. Above that it follows up a flat valley. I went up about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. Fine gravel bottom all the way. It forms a small pond or lake ashshown on the chart.

August 6, 1926.....5,000 humps (few dead) and 12 red salmon.

August 11, 1927.....5,000 fish; 1 red.

August 18, 1928.....500.

August 16, 1929.....4,345 humps.

August 13, 1930.....10.
