

Stream No. 18 (No notice)

East side Shelter Bay, Evans Island.

Three small streams here.

East stream

Width: 8 feet

Depth: 3 inches

Accessible 600 feet.

Has a fine gravel bed and most of the fish.

West stream

Width: 4 feet

Depth: 2 inches

Accessible 1,000 feet.

Good bottom. Small lagoon. Fish thin, and up only 500 feet above lagoon.

Middle stream

Width: 4 feet

Depth: 3 inches

Short.

Aug. 23, 1927: 3,520 fish.

Stream No. 19 (No notice)

West head Shelter Bay, Evans Island.

Width: 6 feet

Depth: 3 inches

Accessible about 1,000 feet

Has a good bottom at mouth, a little coarser upstream.

Aug. 22, 1927: 2,000 fish.

Stream No. 20 (2 notices)

Hogan Bay, Knight Island.

Width: 16 feet

Depth: 3 inches at outside end. (Upper end narrower)

Accessible 700 feet from half tide line.

Coarse gravel bed.

Sept. 1, 1927: 5,650 fish.
