

Stream No. 21 (1 notice)

Fish Bay

Width: 10 feet

Depth: 4 inches

Stream proper near its mouth is rough, blocky rocks. A good gravel bar is exposed for 600 feet at half tide.

Stream No. 22 (2 notices)

Fish Bay.

Width: 6 feet

Depth: 4 inches

Accessible for fish about 1/4 mile. Good gravel bar at mouth. Has a fine gravel bottom.

Stream No. 23 (2 notices)

Fish Bay.

Width: 6 feet

Depth: 6 inches

It comes in through a canyon about 30 feet deep, cut out of soft slate. Bottom is all soft flat slate. A lot of it is fine stuff.

Stream No. 24 (1 notice)

Landlock Bay near Graveyard Point.

Is in 3 parts and comes into a small lagoon. The water combined is 6 feet wide and 6 inches deep. Only one stream is accessible above mean high tide. Is blocked up a good deal with windfalls and rotten logs. Has a rough, rocky bottom. Good gravel around the mouth of all of them.

Sept. 25, 1926: No signs of fish.
