

Stream No. 30 (2 notices)

Port Etches, S. W. side.

Lagoon here with 2 streams entering.

Larger--fartherest north

Width: 20 feet

Depth: 6 inches

Accessible about 1/2 mile from lagoon outlet.

Has a fine gravel and sand bottom.

Smaller

Found dogs in the smaller stream and also in ponds formed on the grass flat.

Aug. 13, 1925: 6,000 fish all told

Aug. 26, 1926: 6,000 fish all told,—3,000 alive, 3,000 dead

Sept. 9, 1927: 1,500 fish.

Stream No. 31 (2 notices)

Port Etches, S.W.Side—lagoon here.

Width: 20 feet

Depth: 8 inches

Accessible about 1/2 mile above mean high tide.

Aug. 13, 1925: 7,000 fish all told

Aug. 26, 1926: 9,500 alive and dead

Sept.10, 1927: 7,700 fish

Stream No. 32 (2 notices)

Port Etches, S.W.side

2 streams here,—lagoon at south one.

South stream

Width: 12 feet ) Measured at lagoon outlet

Depth: 5 inches )

No accessible stream enters lagoon; all seepage.

North stream

Width: 8 feet

Depth: 5 inches

Accessible about 1,000 feet

Has small lagoon and fine gravel bottom.

Aug. 13, 1925: South stream, 3,000 fish alive and dead, mostly dogs; north stream, 20 fish

August 26, 1926: Total both streams, 3,900 fish

Sept. 10, 1927: 3,800 fish
