


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**INTERNATIONAL METEOROLOGY—OCEAN STORM-TRACKS.**

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Data as appearing in the International Bulletin of similar date.  
 Isobars in black exhibit atmospheric pressure at sea-level and are charted from data as reported by the several observers.  
 Isotherms in red exhibit temperature of air, similarly charted.  
 Broken or dotted lines indicate that the lines so broken are doubtful.  
 Arrows, when charted, fly with the wind and exhibit wind-direction and force.

The tracks charted in black have appeared in previous Reviews.

The tracks charted in red have been made from data collected since preceding Review.

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
