


Chart IX. Weather Map of North Atlantic Ocean, March 2, 1929

 Isobars show corrected barometric readings in inches of mercury.
 Arrows fly with the wind.
 Number of feathers indicate force, Beaufort scale.
 Weather symbols are as follows:
 ○ clear, ◐ partly cloudy, ● cloudy,
 ● rain, ▲ hail or sleet, ★ snow,
 ≡ fog.
 Pointed arrows indicate land stations.
 Pairs of numbers indicate temperatures of air and surface of water in Fahrenheit degrees. Upper number, air; lower, water.
