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Weather at the poles! Long continued cold is the order of things at the poles. The distinctive features are the long dark winters and the long summers. In summer the sun is above the horizon continually but is not very high and so the sunshine is weak. The south polar region is land, and the north polar region a land-locked sea, causing noticeable differences in climate. The north pole is milder than the south and has more definite seasons. The interior of Greenland is colder on the average than either the north or south pole. The coldest winter in the world is in northeastern Siberia, not at the poles. The polar precipitation is very scanty; yet it exceeds the evaporation, and hence accumulates into glaciers.
