Magnetic storms and cyclones! We have just had a big cyclone or storm coincident with magnetic storms and auroral displays. Do magnetic storms cause our storms of wind and snow or rain? There always are magnetic storms at times of great sunspot numbers. Sunspots are a phenomenon of long duration. During their periods we have plenty of storms passing over the country, but we have them also when there are few sunspots. There seems to be no causal connection of any wind or rain storm with magnetic storms.
