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Windy March! Tradition has given this month the first place for winds. In the temperate zones it is true that cyclones (or low pressure areas) sweep over the country more frequently and with more intensity in winter than at other seasons. For this reason winds should be strongest during the winter; this is so, and for March in particular. But there are many places where this rule does not apply. At San Francisco July is the windiest month; and at Key West the winds of the fall months equal those of winter. The record for highest wind speed, however, may occur in any month, but mostly records of highest wind speeds were obtained in either October or March.
