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Thunderstorm warnings! Now that boating and other water sports are on the increase, and thunderstorms will soon begin, it especially behooves the mariner of small boats to take heed of thunderstorm winds, which are often very destructive. All know the preliminary symptoms of a coming thunderstorm: the large cumulus clouds turning to anvil shapes, and the squall-cloud, not so easily seen, just below the thunderhead, the decrease of the wind followed by a rush of wind from the storm. By watching the storm closely one can tell the direction of its movement, which is generally from the southwest to northeast, traveling at about 50 miles an hour. Take measures to protect yourself from lightning, too.

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
