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Ocean travel! It is good news for those who experience discomfort in ocean travel to learn that over the North Atlantic storms in April are less severe than formerly and in general the weather is more settled. But storms with winds of gale velocities do occur. May, over the North Atlantic, is more moderate; the storms are lessened both in severity and duration. In the South Atlantic strong northeast trades prevail. May is regarded as a pleasant month to cross the North Atlantic, and as the very pleasantest month of the year to cruise the West Indian and Caribbean waters. Gales in May are rare south of the 35th parallel of latitude.
