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Weather forecasts at sea! For the benefit of the air service and marine interests, the French S.S. Carimaré will be stationed in the Atlantic Ocean at the 39th parallel of latitude and about halfway between New York City and Lisbon, Portugal. This ship will give weather information, including weather forecasts to airships and ocean vessels. The Carimaré will collect information from all vessels, but more especially from two other French vessels which will collect and relay the information. Weather notes published in the morning papers of Atlantic liners are read with great interest by all passengers at the breakfast table. Weather information, including forecasts, is of greatest value to navigators.
