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Clouds, red and white! No artist has ever succeeded in painting the soft transparent colors in sky and cloud. Light coming from the sun is composed of all colors, but when seen in a bundle is white. The color of any object depends upon what light illuminates it and what colors are reflected to our eyes. Clouds with full sunlight upon them are thus white, because they reflect all colors equally well. But they are under other conditions, red, or yellow. When the sun shines through a dusty atmosphere only the red waves can get through, and when a cloud is illuminated with that kind of sunlight it appears red. Other conditions may make it appear orange or yellow. -----
