Trees may indicate wind direction! In many places trees proclaim the prevailing wind direction by the way in which they lean. At Banff, Canada, the trees at the Banff Springs Golf Course indicate very clearly the direction of the prevailing wind as those winds caused the trees to grow out of the upright. This is because there is a more continuous mechanical pressure against the foliage and trunk from the direction the wind blows most than from any other. This phenomenon is different from that of plants which incline toward the sun, and therefore never toward the north.
