"Gather leaves and grasses,
For the autumn passes."

This is a month of harvest. In the North, potatoes with dead tops should be dug. It is recommended that if cabbage heads begin to crack, bend them so as to break the roots on one side. Celery should be carefully banked. But in the South sowing and planting may be continued. Turnips and radishes should be planted, and if desired lettuce may still be sown, also spinach and parsley for spring use.
