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Just water! Did you ever taste chemically pure water? That is, water of just one part oxygen and two parts hydrogen. You would not like it, for it is really unpalatable. The water we like to drink contains salts derived from the soil or rocks through which it seeps. Rain water is the purest water in nature, containing only slight amounts of ammonium salts taken from the air. Sea water has 35 parts salt to 1000 parts water, and is from one to five per cent. heavier than pure water. Pure water is easily obtained by distilling or freezing ordinary water.

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
