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Czechoslovakia's climate! The climate of this country can not be exactly compared with that of any part of the United States or Canada; it may be said, however, to have temperatures similar to those of Denver, and precipitation similar in amount and distribution to that of Winnipeg, Canada. The annual mean temperature varies from 43.1 degrees at Aravavaralja to 49.2 at Uzhorod. Prague, the principal city, has an annual mean temperature of 48.2 degrees, a July mean of 67 and a January mean of 30 degrees. The rainfall is about 20 inches a year; of this 69 per cent falls in the winter half of the year and 31 per cent in the summer half. June and July are the wettest months and February the driest.
