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Daily temperature ranges! Everyone has, of course, noted the daily march of temperature being usually coldest just before sunrise and warmest between 2 and 4 p.m. The amount of this daily range depends upon (1) the kind of day, (2) the location of the station, and (3) the season. It is greater on clear than on cloudy days, least in the tropics and over the seas, and more in summer than in winter. The greatest daily ranges are found in the interior of large continents, like central Siberia and the Sahara. At the latter place the temperature in August often varies as much as 55 degrees in a single day.
