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The staubosphere! It is believed that the dust in the air is as wide spread as the atmosphere itself, and so a new word has been coined for this dust content. "Staubosphere": simply means the dust of the atmosphere. Dust plays a very large and important part in all human affairs. We generally note the unpleasant part - getting into our eyes and noses - but it also beneficently intercepts some of the sunlight, dispersing it and making it bearable. By intercepting the rays, it also warms the air, which is quite transparent to the sun's rays. Dust also has important geological effects. Ordinary air contains about two million dust particles for every cubic inch.
