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The ocean in November! If you cross the Atlantic in November, the chances are that you will experience some stormy weather. The winter type of storm has set in, and sometimes one of the severest storms of the cold-weather season occurs during the month. The stormiest weather, as a rule, is found north of the 45th parallel, and decreases in severity southward. Fogs have decreased in area and frequency over northern and western waters. In the southern waters of the Atlantic the weather is seldom stormy this month. In November the West Indian hurricanes have a frequency of only one in two years.
