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Temperature of the earth! For the past hundreds of millions of years plants and animals have been able to live on the earth. During this long period it has never been too hot or too cold, which is remarkable when one thinks of the rather narrow range of temperature necessary for life - somewhat below the freezing point to something below the boiling point. These temperatures were maintained by the wonderful balancing of many forces and factors. Further, it is remarkable when one thinks of the absolute range of temperature possible, for it varies from 490 degrees below zero Fahrenheit (absolute zero) to millions of degrees, probably, in the interiors of stars.
