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Wind and weather! Everyone wants to know of signs in the sky that will tell of coming weather. Unfortunately there are none, that is, no infallible ones. The wind, its direction or change in direction and its speed, is a fairly good sign. When the wind changes from northwest or west with increased speed to more southerly points, then a cold front is probably on the way. When the cold front passes, the wind will veer from south or southwest to northwest or north. This veering will occur quite suddenly and with a drop in temperature which is often sharp. The accuracy of forecasts made from these wind signs is increased if attended by a fall of the barometer.
